WEEKLY UPDATES

Dvar Torah

This week's parashah opens, "He called to Moshe." It does not say, "G-d called to Moshe," because, explains Rabbeinu Bachya z"l (14th century; Spain), it is understood that our parashah continues where last week's parashah left off. There we read (Shmot 40:34-35), "The cloud covered the Ohel Moed / Tent of Meeting, and the glory of Hashem filled the Tabernacle. Moshe could not enter the Ohel Moed, for the cloud rested upon it, and the Glory of Hashem filled the Tabernacle." Our parashah opens, "He" – meaning that same "Glory of Hashem"- "called to Moshe." The call to Moshe was an indication that the Glory of Hashem had constricted itself into the Kodesh Ha'kodashim / Holy of Holies, thus informing Moshe that he now could enter the Ohel Moed.

Rabbeinu Bachya adds: This call came from the small letter "heh" in the word (Bereishit 2:4) "be'hibarram" / "when they were created." This also is the reason for the small "aleph" in "Vayikra" / "He called" (at the beginning of our parashah). What does this mean? R' Zev Hoberman shlita explains: As just noted, we find a verse in the Torah that contains a small letter "heh". There also is a verse (Devarim 32:6) that contains a large letter "heh". The Vilna Gaon z"l explains that these two letters, each of which has a gematria of five, allude to the five similarities between G-d and man's soul (see Berachot 10a). Of course, G-d is greater than we can conceive, and any divine qualities that the soul has are infinitesimal compared to G-d. Thus, the one "heh" is large and the other is small. Says R' Hoberman: for G-d to make room for Moshe in the Ohel Moed, so-to-speak, G-d had to constrict His Glory to a mere shadow of Itself, just as the divine qualities that the soul possesses are a mere shadow of G-d Himself. This is what Rabbeinu Bachya meant when he wrote that the small "heh" called to Moshe. For the same reason, the "aleph" of "He called" is small, for were G-d to reveal Himself in all His Glory, even Moshe could not enter the Ohel Moed.

Shabbos Day

Parshas Zachor- a once a year Mitzvah D'oraisa will be leined for maftir at each minyan with an additional leining at the end of the second minyan right before kiddush- Approximately at 10:40.

Shabbos ends at 7:55-(60 minutes).


One should say "Baruch Hamavdil Bein Kodesh Lichol" and then drive to shul with all megilla items/costumes. It is appropriate to wear Shabbos clothing for the Megillah Reading. Havdalah will be made in shul after the megillah is completed. One should have a small festive meal after hearing the megillah. This does not count for the regular Purim day meal.

Sunday- Purim Day: There are 4 special mitzvos of Purim day:

- Mitzvah #1 (Reading of the Megillah) קריאת מגילה. This Mitzvah is for both men and women to hear every word of Megillas Esther two times, once at night (Saturday night) and once during the day (Sunday).
- Mitzvah #2 (Mishloach Manos) משׁלוֹח מנות This Mitzvah is for both men and women to send at least two types of "ready to eat" foods to at least one person. Husband and wife can fulfill this Mitzvah together in one package with double the amount of food. This Mitzvah is fulfilled during Purim day (Sunday). Additionally, it should be sent through a messenger.
- Mitzvah #3 (Funds for the Poor) מתנוֹת לאביוֹנם This Mitzvah is for both men and women to give one gift to two poor people each (i.e., a total of two gifts, one to each poor individual). Wives may rely on their husbands to fulfill this Mitzvah. It must be given on Purim day. The minimum amount that is required is "a meal's value" which nowadays would be about \$5.00-\$7.00 for each poor person. However, Purim is a time to give freely; if one is able, it is praiseworthy to do so. We are giving the money to the poor of our community through Aishel Avraham.
- Mitzvah #4 (Purim meal) סעוּדת פּוּרים This Mitzvah is for both men and women to partake in a festive meal. The meal should consist of meat and wine and should be accompanied with songs and words of Torah. Most of the meal should be eaten during Purim day before sunset (6:55). We say the prayer of "Al Hanissim" in the Birchas Hamazon.




